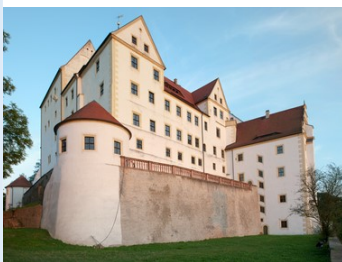
September 19th, Social Evening
